Literature Content, books and research papers prepared by the faculty member, as well as regulatory documents and other information sources	The person devising the course offers various materials which can be: 1. A file of teaching materials that he or she has prepared, which is available to students in electronic format; 2. A list of regulatory documents that apply to the contents of the course, in accordance with the description of the study course, as well as an additional list of literature in electronic format, research papers and other materials.								
4.	Theoretical material	The person devising the course specifies the order in which the course is to be taken. Theoretical material can be offered in the form of presentations or thematic materials.								
5.	Descriptions of test work assignments and/or methodological instructions and assessment criteria	Potential versions of independent work: individual assignments; tests or average assessment of tests.
