

## ACADEMIC STAFF PEER REVIEW PROCEDURE AT RISEBA

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RISEBA peer review system is developed to improve the study quality. Entire faculty is involved in the peer review: everyone is assessed by the colleagues and everyone is an evaluator, too. The peer review system ensures information and experience exchange within the faculty with an aim to improve the study quality.

### The basic rules of peer review

- 1. Every faculty participates in another faculty's classes and makes assessment at least four times per academic year, or two times per semester.
- 2. In order to involve all faculty in the peer review procedure, there is developed a special peer review plan. The plan is developed by the Head of Department and is introduced to the entire faculty.
- 3. In order to record the peer review results and to make a systemic assessment, a special Peer review form is used for the assessment (annexed). The form includes pedagogic and academic assessment.
- 4. The assessed faculty is introduced to the assessment results, acknowledging it with a signature on the peer review form. The faculty assessed is taking into account the assessment results in the further teaching activities.
- 5. Fulfilled peer review forms are collected by the Head of Department. The results of the peer review are taken into account for assessment of the study process and the faculty assessment. However, the peer review results do not have direct impact to the faculty fee rate.

#### The peer review procedure

- 1. The entire faculty makes plans for the review of other faculty by recording it in a common peer review plan, available at the Head of the department. All the faculty have two roles there "A reviewer", and "A faculty to be assessed". The Head of the Department is responsible for peer review planning and implementation. Peer review plan is sent to the entire faculty. The plan is used by the Head of department for monitoring of the peer review process.
- 2. Before the classes, the reviewer makes contact to the faculty about his/her presence in the class. It is recommended to inform the faculty 6-12 hours before the classes. The faculty does not have to prepare any special classes and any special presentation for



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- the peer review. In order to ease the communication, the contact information of entire faculty is included the peer review plan.
- 3. During the lesson, the reviewer fills a peer review form, making the notes there according to the activities seen in the lesson, and makes recommendations and suggestions for improvements. A filled form is presented to the faculty assessed, and both sides sign the form. Both the reviewer and the faculty assessed discuss the lesson and potential improvements, if any.
- 4. The Peer review form is submitted to the Head of the department. Head of department also checks the availability of the learning materials of the faculty reviewed in e.riseba (Moodle), and makes a mark about it on the peer review form.
- 6. Head of department collects all the peer review forms and follows the implementation of the peer review plan.
- 7. Head of the Department uses the peer review information for the following purposes:
  - For identification of essential problems (e.g. technical, pedagogic, organizational) in the faculty teaching quality, and develops solutions for solving the problems;
  - For observation of specific tendencies and implementation of the relevant activities (e.g. organization of methodological workshop on an essential topic)
  - For assessment of the faculty work quality.
