RISEBA Admission Test Organisation Work Procedures PR0035-01

The RISEBA Admission Test is an entrance examination that is regulated by the RISEBA Admission terms and conditions for the relevant academic year. The RISEBA Admission Test Organisation Work Procedure is drawn up in accordance with the RISEBA Admission Process (PR0034-01).

Work procedure

1. The student has paid the registration fee for studies at RISEBA (See International Student Admission Process *PR0034-01*) and has received an automatic message from the DreamApply system regarding the schedule for taking the Admission Test and other entrance examinations (*feedback 2*);

2. **On Fridays:** The International Student Coordinator collates the list of students. By 17:00, an email is sent to the IT Department;

3. **On Mondays:** The IT Department issues students with a username and password and sends the list o the International Student Coordinator;

4. **On Tuesdays:** The International Student Coordinator informs the student that 3 business days have been allocated for taking the Admission Test, from Wednesday to Friday. Sends the student a link to take the test, as well as a username and password;

5. From Wednesday to Friday, the student takes the test;

6. **On Mondays:** The IT Department receives the test results and sends out a list of results to the International Student Coordinator by 17.00;

7. The International Student Coordinator delivers the examination results to the Head of the Study Department, who enters them in the protocol;

8. If the student has reached the 40% test threshold, within 3 business days he or she will be notified of the test results and will continue the admission process. The International Student Coordinator changes the student's status within the DreamApply system to *Conditionally Accepted*, sending *feedback (4.)* on the test results and information about the next steps for admission to studies at RISEBA.

9. If the student has not reached the 40% test threshold, within 3 business days he or she will be notified of the test results and will not continue the admission process. The International Student Coordinator changes the student's status within the DreamApply system to *Failed*, sending *feedback (3.)* on the test results and confirmation that the student has been denied access to studies at RISEBA.
