The higher education contract and the first payment must be made no later than 31<sup>st</sup> of July (summer admission) or 31<sup>st</sup> of December (winter admission).

Abbreviations used and their explanations:

The discount for the first year of studies — upon admission to the first course, in the first semester of the first year of studies

Discount for one year of studies — regardless of the time of admission, for one year of studies

The Discount Committee shall, in special cases, have the right to apply the tuition fee discounts specified in these Regulations to other programmes and to decide on additional tuition fee discounts which are not specified in these Regulations.

If several discounts are applied to one student, each subsequent discount shall be calculated from the sum, taking the previous discount into account. To calculate the total discount sum, the formula  $(a+b-a*b)$ , where  $a$  – 1<sup>st</sup> discount  $b$  – 2<sup>nd</sup> discount, e.g.,  $a - 20\% b - 25\% 0.2+0.25-0.2*0.25=0.40$  or  $20+25-20*25/100=40$ ) shall be applied. If several discounts are applied to one student, their total sum shall not exceed 50%.
