Evaluation of the objectivity of study assessments

1. RISEBA University of Applied Sciences (hereinafter - RISEBA) strives for the highest quality service standards and is open for continuous development and improvement. These Regulations establish the procedure and form in which the objectivity of study assessments is evaluated at RISEBA.
2. The evaluation of the objectivity of study assessments is carried out twice a year after the end of the semester.
3. The IT Department provides the Study Quality Centre with data on the study courses of a given study semester, their teaching staff and final grades received in a each study course.
4. The Study Quality Center conducts an in-depth analysis of student achievements based on the following criteria:
 - 4.1. The average grade of final evaluations in a study course is equal to or higher than 9;
 - 4.2. The average grade of final evaluations in a study course is equal to or lower than 5;
 - 4.3. The standard deviation of final evaluations in a study course is equal to or lower than 1.
5. The average grade check is performed in study courses in which at least 5 students have participated during the study semester.
6. The standard deviation check is performed in study courses in which at least 15 students have participated during the study semester.
7. The in-depth examination is carried out by employees of the Study Quality Center, reviewing the evaluation system of the study course and reviewing the criteria for placing evaluations. The results of the examination are reported to the Head of Quality assurance, Vice Rector for Academic Affairs, Dean, Head of the Department, and the Director of the respective study program.
8. Department Heads and Program Directors hold discussions with faculty.
9. Information about the examination results is stored in the Study Quality Center for each individual study course and instructor.
